

## BECOME AN INTERN AT THE ROYAL DANISH CONSULATE GENERAL IN ISTANBUL

Two full-time internships are available for Masters-level students for the Spring semester, starting February 2022 and lasting to (and including) July 2023.

Interns are an essential and integral part of the Consulate General's day-to-day activities. We are therefore looking for dynamic and motivated interns that are team players, while being able to take on tasks and responsibility individually. Written and spoken Danish and English is required. Knowledge of Turkish is an advantage, but not required.

An internship at the Consulate General in Istanbul provides an opportunity to experience work at a Danish diplomatic mission that works closely with the Embassy in Ankara and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Copenhagen. It is an opportunity to become involved in a broad variety of tasks that are key to the Danish foreign service, including:

- Assisting the Danish business community with their internationalization activities in Turkey, working both with Danish companies already established in Turkey or companies looking to enter the Turkish market. Interns will be working under the direction of Trade Council Turkey team on a wide variety of tasks, including business development and public affairs.
- Being part of public diplomacy activities, providing information on Danish values, experiences and know-how to a targeted audience through social media and other channels. The Consulate General carries out a number of larger events annually in which the interns are involved.
- Providing various assistance to the on-going Peace and Stabilisation Programme for Syria and Iraq, providing an insight into Danish foreign and development policy priorities as well as engaging with non-governmental partner organisations.

The internship is unpaid, but a monthly subsidy of 4.000 DKK will be granted as a contribution to living expenses.
